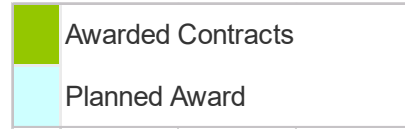

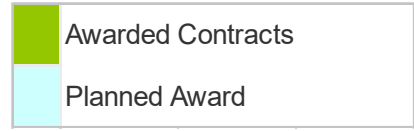
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- The Draft EWPMT RFP was released to potential vendors on 14 October 2022

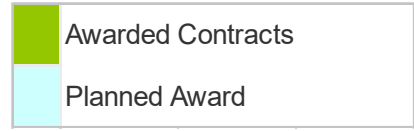
