WHAT: PNT provides trusted and resilient data, when needed, to the Soldier and platforms

WHY: PNT is a critical enabler providing location and timing for most Army systems

HOW: Establish a PNT Modernization Strategy for the Army; Develop Requirements; Synchronize efforts across Research Development and Acquisition communities; Reduce the number of different solutions; guide development of open PNT architectures; Eliminate vendor unique solutions

Tactical Space



WHAT: Ensure Tactical Land Component Forces have access to required space-based capabilities (Communications, ISR and PNT) critical to Force Projection and Maneuver in LSCO and MDO

WHY: Tactical space efforts are critical enablers and will reduce identified gaps to protected communications, assured PNT, deep sensing and rapid, responsive long range targeting capabilities to support tactically responsive operations in a MDO environment

HOW: Partner with Industry, Joint Services and OGAs to leverage and demonstrate tactically responsive space technologies at echelon. Accelerate LRPF, FVL and NGCV targeting and SA using direct access and AI/ML to deliver mobile capabilities

WHY: NAVWAR is a critical enabler to preserve friendly and counter adversary use of the EMS, to include PNT.




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
