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# PD Sensors Aerial Intelligence



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- PD SAI, more specifically Product Manager Manned Aerial Reconnaissance and Surveillance Systems (PdM MARSS), plans to consolidate like contract requirements in an effort to reduce duplicative efforts, and reduce risks and complications with operations, sustainment and maintenance of aging deployed and non deployed systems. By consolidating the requirement and having one prime contractor responsible for the operations and sustainment of these systems, the Government would benefit from less transitions, minimize divergent and duplicative efforts, gain better oversight of GFP, training and maintenance efficiencies, as well as receive economies of scale for purchases, all of which contribute to improved efficiency and improvement to performance.
- A sources sought notice was posted for Development, Integration, Acquisition and Bridging to Logistics & Operations (DIABLO) services and supplies for portfolio requirements on 26 May 2022 to sam.gov with responses from industry due 8 July 2022.

- PD SAI will be responsible for determining/procuring best of breed payloads and GFE'ing them to PEO AVN for Air Launched Effects Program

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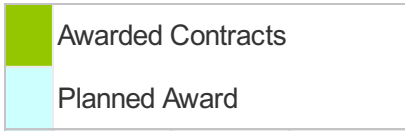

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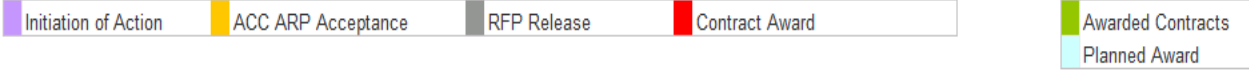
