LTC Don Bell began his Army career in 2003, enlisting as an Intelligence
Analyst with the 313th Military Intelligence Battalion, 82nd Airborne Division,

Fort Bragg, North Carolina, and deployed with the 18th Airborne Corps and MNC-I G-2 in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom. In 2006, he commissioned into the Military Intelligence (MI) Corps through Officer Candidate School Program at Ft. Benning, GA, and served his first assignment at Fort Bragg, North Carolina. There, LTC Bell served in the 82nd Airborne Division's Analytical Control Element (G-2) and deployed in support of Operation Enduring Freedom as the Deputy Collection Manager for Regional Command-East. He later served as the Battalion Intelligence Officer for 2-321 Field Artillery, 4th Brigade Combat Team, and deployed again in support of

Operation Enduring Freedom across Regional Commands-West and South.

LTC Bell's next assignment was in Warner Robins, GA, where he served as the Deputy Mission Crew Command for Army JSTARS and deployed in support of both Operation Enduring Freedom and Operation Iraqi Freedom. LTC Bell also deployed in support of USAFRICOM for Operation Juniper Micron in Mali before assuming command the 138th Military Intelligence Company with the same mission. Don served his final assignment as a MI officer as the Executive Officer to the US Army Forces Command G2 at Ft. Bragg, North Carolina.

After transitioning to the Army Acquisition Workforce, LTC Bell was assigned to Redstone Arsenal, AL, where he served as the Assistant Product Manager (APM) for the Common Infrared Countermeasures (CIRCM) within the Program Management Office for Aircraft Survivability, supporting all required testing for the ACAT 1D program's Milestone C decision. He went on to serve as the Executive Officer to the PEO IEW&S and APM for the Tactical Intelligence Targeting Access Node (TITAN) at Aberdeen Proving Ground, MD.

LTC Bell has recently completed an assignment to Deputy Assistant Secretary of the Army for Plans, Programs, and Resources (DASA-PPR) within ASA (ALT) managing several PEO portfolios for financial execution and is currently working within ASA (ALT) CHOPS focusing on Ukraine and Taiwan support.
